## Clam Lake Information

Even though it's the smallest lake in the lower chain of Antrim County's Chain-of-Lakes, Clam Lake is still one of the busiest. With a full DNR launch site, a launch site at Butch's Tackle & Marine, and the largest marina on the Chain-of-Lakes, Dewitt Marine, **Clam Lake offers more boating access to the public, based on size, than any other lake in Antrim County.**

Clam Lake offers all the following:

- a destination with great fishing, skiing, or tubing
- a thoroughfare to the Grass River Natural Area, 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks, or the Torch Lake sandbar
- a safe harbor when storms and winds pick up on Torch Lake
- the place where you probably learned to ski or where you taught your kids or grandkids
- the largest full-service general store on the water at Butch's Tackle & Marine
- one of only two full-service restaurants on the Chain-of-Lakes - Docksider (the other is on Elk Lake)
